Dear Neighbour

Main Street and Lullington Road Regeneration

I am writing to update you on the progress of our development at Main Street and Lullington Road.

Since we last wrote to you in October, we have completed the demolition of the Airey homes and all excess spoil has been removed meaning the site is now clear. I would like to thank you for your patience and support during these works.

We know that Christmas is a time for family and friends and with that in mind I can confirm that the site will be closed over this period with no construction activity from 20th December until 2nd January 2019. From this date onwards until around March/April, the ground workers will be continuing setting out the site, including constructing the new roadways within the site. We anticipate the working hours to be between 7.30am and 5pm Monday to Friday however there may be the occasional need to work on a Saturday between 8am and 1pm. We will make every effort to avoid needing to do this.

During early January there will be a requirement for a partial road closure including controlled by traffic lights on Main Street opposite the site entrance. This is expected to last about three days and peak travel times, including school times, will be avoided where possible.

Bromford offices will be closed from 2pm on 24th December until 9am on 2nd January, and we will not be contactable during that period other than for reporting emergencies to our call centre on 0330 1234034.

For queries before or after the Christmas break, you should contact neighbourhood coach Vikki Monteith on 07718 966228. The site manager Tim Hotchkiss will be back on site in the New Year and he can be contacted on 07894 598343.

I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge your cooperation during the works as we do appreciate that living close to a building site can be noisy and inconvenient at times.
